THE UNIVERSITY

Maharshi Dayanand University, initially known as Rohtak University, Rohtak was established by an Act of Legislature of Haryana in 1976 with the object to promote inter-disciplinary higher studies and research in the field of environmental, ecological and life sciences. Initially it was a unitary and residential University. However, its character was changed to an affiliating University. It was named after the great revolutionary and social reformer Maharshi Dayanand and came to be known as Maharshi Dayanand University, Rohtak.



The University Grants Commission recognized this University under section 2(f) for the recognition of degrees and under section 12(b) of the University Grants Commission Act for central grants on Feb.2,1983.

Location

The University is situated at Rohtak, a rapidly growing town and district headquarter which is about 75 kms. away from Delhi on Delhi-Hissar National Highway (NH-10). It is at a distance of about 240 kms from Chandigarh, the State Capital. It is well connected by rail and road. Rohtak is an educationally advanced town where facilities of education in all fields are available. Besides the prestigious Pt. Bhagwat Dayal Sharma Post Graduate Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, there are as many as 37 Colleges in Rohtak city alone besides one Govt. Dental College, 13 Colleges of Education, 6 Degree Colleges, 3 Girls' Colleges and 2 Ayurveda and other Professional Colleges.

Jurisdiction

This University exercises its powers over colleges or institutions of general education, technology, engineering, pharmacy, management and medical education in the districts of Rohtak, Jhajjar, Mohindergarh, Gurgaon, Faridabad, Sonapat, Bhiwani and Rewari, Post-Graduate Regional Centre, Mirpur (Rewari), Medical College, Agroha also fall under the academic control of the University.

Provided the State Government of Haryana on the merits and demerits of each case may grant No Objection Certificate to an institution to be established in the area falling under National Capital Region as defined in National Capital Planning Board Act, 1985 (Act 2 of 1985), but within the territorial jurisdiction of this University for affiliation with the Indraprastha Vishavidyalaya (University) Delhi.

Campus

The University Campus is spread over a sprawling area of over 700 acres. The boundary of the campus extends from Rohtak-Delhi Road to Rohtak-Delhi railway line and from Pt. BDS PGIMS to Western Yamuna Canal. The campus is well laid with numerous buildings and wide road network. It presents a spectacle of harmony between architecture and natural beauty. There are as many as 10 teaching blocks, 9 hostels, a Central Library, Campus School, Health Centre, Faculty House, Sports Stadium, Community Centre, Swimming Pool, Multipurpose Gymnasium Hall, Shopping Complex and an Administrative Block.



More than 424 residential houses are available for faculty members and non-teaching staff. Completion of a magnificent Auditorium is going on. Two branches of State Bank of India and Central Co-operative Bank are available on the Campus.

Accreditation by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC)

The University Grants Commission has an autonomous National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), which has been assigned the task of accreditation and assessment of the Universities and colleges. The Peer Team of the NAAC visited the University on February 18-20, 2003 for assessment and accreditation of the University. On the basis of the report submitted by the team, the National Assessment and Accreditation Council has graded Maharshi Dayanand University B++ Grade with institutional score of 80.25. The Peer Team was highly impressed by the infrastructural facilities available in the University. It made highly laudable comments about the teaching, learning and evaluation system of the University. It also observed that the University has developed potential for achieving excellence in teaching, research and extension. The University endeavors to harvest the available resources to achieve excellence for which there is great potential.

University Teaching Departments

There are 33 Teaching Departments in the University, which provide postgraduate teaching and research. M.B.A. programme offered by our University has been ranked among the best 50 management courses. Similarly M.C.A. course of the University is one of the best 20 computer training programmes of the country. The Department of Sociology and the Department of Psychology are covered under Special Assistance Programme of the UGC. Similarly, Department of Physics and Department of Chemistry are covered under F.I.S.T. of the Department of Science & Technology of the Government of India for which financial assistance to the tune of Rs. 30 lacs for Department of Chemistry and Rs. 9 lacs for Department of Physics has been provided by the Govt. of India. The X Plan UGC's Visiting Expert Committee made the following observations about the Departments :-

“Performance of Bio-Sciences and Social Sciences is excellent. University has a well managed & utilized Central Library. The committee appreciated the initiatives proposed by the University namely Institute of Development Studies (IDS) and Centre of Indian System of Medicine. Some of the Departments have publications of National and International repute to their credit. Departments also organize seminars, symposia and conferences.”

The Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences, has laudable achievements to its credit. Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences, one of the youngest Departments of M.D. University, Rohtak came into existence in only 1995, with the admission of 1st batch of B.Pharmacy with the strength of 45 students. Subsequently M.Pharm. course in Industrial Pharmacy and Drug Regulatory Affairs were introduced in

Sept. 2003 and July 2004 respectively with prior approval from All India Council of Technical Education, with an intake of 8 students in each course. The Department, which started from a scratch in 1995, has made rapid strides in all the spheres.

The Department of Computer Science & Applications and Institute of Management Studies & Research have highly sophisticated computer labs with more than 150 computers with internet facility. Computer papers have been introduced in each course with a view to make the students aware of computer applications in their fields of education. Computer labs are also available in almost all the Departments of the University. Lab equipments of latest technology are available in the labs of all Departments for teaching and research.

Central Library

The Central Library is the nerve center of the University. Every year more than Rs.75 lacs are spent on the purchase of books and research journals. There are about 300000 books including back sets of journals. 570 Journals including magazines/newspapers are subscribed to by the University Library. The Library subscribes to 2000 E-Journals through UGC Infonet Project. For Internet Based Services, internet connection is available to 100 Computer Sets in the Library. The extended part of the library building has started functioning w.e.f. November, 2007. University Library is a three storeyed building with a constructed area of 84,000 sq.ft. The Library remains open from 9.00 a.m. to 8.00 p.m. on all the days of the year (except on five national holidays). The Rear Hall of the Library remains open round the clock.

The library has 5 Reading-cum-Stack halls, two seminar halls, one Video Library, Thesis and Rare Book Section, Reference Text Book Section, Text Book Section, Digital/E-Library Section. The Library has seating capacity for 1100 readers at a time. The Departments of Law, Institute of Management Studies and Research (IMSAR), Engg.& Tech./MCA/DDE, Sociology and Mathematics have departmental libraries. Moreover, the Departments of Pharmacy, Physical Education, Economics, Education, Geography, Psychology also have departmental libraries. The University is planning to strengthen departmental libraries.

Directorate of Distance Education

In addition to regular courses, the University is running courses through Directorate of Distance Education for the benefit of students, particularly girl students and those of working class who are unable to enroll themselves in regular courses. The courses being run through distance education mode are shown in programme at glance.



Encouraged by the overwhelming response for undergraduate and postgraduate **DIRECTORATE OF DISTANCE EDUCATION** has established study centres in various affiliated colleges and the University Teaching Departments. The instructions through study material are supplemented by personal contact programme (PCP of 20 day face-to-face counselling session for UG/PG classes; 80% attendance in the PCP in B.L.I.Sc. and 50% attendance in PCP in M.L.I.Sc. is mandatory for every student. The counseling sessions are normally held on Sundays/ Holidays. Defence personnel are exempted from attending PCP. For Computer/ Information Technology programme, Study Centres have been established all over India. A continuous evaluation through assignments and internal tests is the hallmark of our distance education programme. Study material in the form of books is provided to the distance learners and the same is supplemented by extra reading material through University website. The Directorate has a well established library where students get facilities and guidance for writing assignments.

Hostels

There are 9 Hostels (4 for Boys and 5 for Girls) which have capacity of as many as 1280 residents. The hostels provide a homely atmosphere. Each Girls' Hostel is looked after by a full time Lady Warden. Indoor games and recreational facilities are available in all the Hostels. STD and canteen facilities are also made available to the residents. Mess in each Hostel is being run by the residents on cooperative basis and hygienic food at very reasonable charges is made available to the residents.

Students Activities and Sports

University possesses excellent infrastructural sports facilities. Its Sports Complex has Swimming Pool of international standard, Squash Court, Standardised Athletic Track and a modern gymnasium hall. Our 45-50 teams participate in All India Inter-University Tournaments annually and our students have shown very good performance in sports. ([UNIVERSITY SWIMMING POOL](#)



Softball teams have won first positions in All India Inter-University tournaments.

University Health Centre

The University Health Centre offers clinical and emergency services. One full time doctor is available along with para medical staff. The Health Centre caters to the primary health care needs of entire student community, teaching and non-teaching staff of the University. Pt.B.D.Post Graduate Institute of Medical Sciences where all medical facilities are available is adjacent to the University.

Cafeteria

The University is running two Canteens on no profit no loss basis which are fully furnished and provide all basic amenities to the students on very reasonable rates.

Computer Centre

The University has a well maintained Computer Centre with the financial assistance of UGC for use of teachers and students of various University Teaching Departments and the University Offices.

Guidance and Counselling Cell - A Centre for Positive Health

University has established a 'Guidance and Counseling Cell - A Centre of Positive Health' in the Department of Psychology for the University students with the objective to

provide Health Care and promotional services. Cell provides Educational and Vocational guidance. To cater to the psychological needs of the students, the centre provides personal and career counseling as well. The vision of the Cell is to benefit the students in boosting harmonious interpersonal relations alongwith developing effective communication skills.

ELIGIBILITY

FOR ADMISSION TO UNDER GRADUATE COURSES

Evidence of required academic performance must be in the form of certified transcripts in English listing all the courses with the grades or marks earned. Transcripts in languages other than English are not acceptable. Applicants for any of the Under-Graduate Course must have completed 12 years of schooling. A student seeking admission to an Under-Graduate Course must fulfill any of the following requirements:

1. General Certificate of Education Examination of U.K. with at least 5 principal passes at "O" Level and 2 principal passes at "A" level (seven in all).
- OR
2. Final School Certificate Examination held after 12 years of schooling or any other 12 grade examination considered equivalent to Senior Secondary School Certificate Examination (12 years) of Board of School Education, Haryana, Bhiwani, India.
 3. Pre-University examination (2 years after 10 years of schooling of any recognized Indian University/Board).
 4. East African Certificate of Education/West African School Certificate Examination and with at least two subjects at Principal/Advanced level of the Higher School Certificate Examination or any Diploma of one year duration of any recognized University/Board held after the final School Certificate Examination.

FOR ADMISSION TO POST GRADUATE COURSES

For admission to a post-graduate programme of studies in any discipline one must have completed 12 years of formal education at the school level followed by a Bachelor's Degree of at least 3 years' duration. However, the admission to post-graduate courses is rather restricted and the applicant should have an excellent academic record to stand a fair chance for admission. Further, the admissions to general seats of post graduate courses (Course-wise) are made through the entrance test conducted by the University well before the commencement of the academic session on the basis of merit in the qualifying examination. But the admissions against the additional seats over and above the total intake (course-wise) for foreign candidates will be made strictly on the basis of merit in the qualifying examination and the applicants i.e. foreign students are not required to appear in the entrance test.

EQUIVALENCY/RECOGNITION OF EXAMINATIONS

All the examinations of the Foreign Universities/Boards/Examining Bodies which have been recognized by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU), New Delhi are recognized by the M.D.University for the purpose of admission to higher courses.

FOR ADMISSION TO M.PHIL AND PH.D. COURSES

Maharshi Dayanand University, Rohtak also offers M.Phil. in fourteen courses and Ph.D. Courses in almost in all Departments/Faculties. Number of seats in these courses is limited and is decided by the respective Departments/Faculties on the basis of academic record along with a detailed research proposal. The minimum admission requirement for a research

degree (Ph.D.) is a Master's Degree with atleast 55% marks in the aggregate in the subject concerned or in an allied subject or a Master of Philosophy Degree (M.Phil.) from any Indian University or any other Degree recognized as equivalent to it.

ACADEMIC CALENDER

University Academic Year is divided into three terms:

- First term : 1st July to 30th September
Second term : 10th October to 24th December
Third term : 2nd January to 12th April

The University Examinations are generally held at the end of the third term i.e. in April/May.

VACATIONS

- Autumn vacations : 1st October to 9th October
Winter vacations : 25th December to 1st January
Summer vacations : 1st May to 30th June

Note :- The above terms & vacations are tentative subject to minor changes.

ADDITIONAL SEATS FOR FOREIGN STUDENTS

There is a provision to create 15% additional supernumerary seats for foreign candidates in each University Teaching Department with the consent of the Head of the Department, out of which 5% seats shall be earmarked for the Children of Indian Workers in the Gulf countries and South East Asia. However, these seats will not be filled up, if foreign candidates/children of Indian Workers in Gulf Countries and South East Asia are not available. Admissions against these seats will be made strictly on the basis of merit in the qualifying examination and the applicants are not required to appear in the entrance test wherever prescribed.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Maharshi Dayanand University, Rohtak does not have any provision for scholarships to the Foreign Students. However, some scholarships are granted by the Govt. of India under various Schemes. Students are advised to contact the nearest Indian Mission for necessary information about these scholarships. Students may also consult the UNESCO Handbook of Study Abroad which lists some scholarships and the addresses of the institutions which provide such scholarships.

FOREIGN STUDENTS' CENTRE

All eligible applicants seeking admission to courses offered by Maharshi Dayanand University, Rohtak are advised to send their applications on the prescribed form (Appendix-II) alongwith duplicate photostat copies of the transcripts/transcript copies (in English version) of the marks sheet of the qualifying examination and letter of the Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi regarding equivalency/recognition of the examination to Advisor, Foreign Students' Centre, Maharshi Dayanand University, Rohtak – 124001. Office of the Foreign Students Centre is located at the ground floor of the Administrative Block. If the applicant is found eligible and fulfills all the qualifications and other conditions, the University will issue provisional admission letter to the candidate. No foreign student will be admitted to this University without a passport and valid visa. However, a foreign student is also required to submit AIDS Certificate at the time of admission.

All private affiliated colleges as well as University Teaching Departments should obtain eligibility certificate of Foreign Students from Foreign Students Centre before their admission.

The admission of foreign students to Medical and Engineering Colleges is undertaken by the Ministry of External Affairs, Govt. of India, New Delhi and to B. Pharmacy/Architectural and MBA Courses by the Ministry of Human Resource Development (Department of Education), Govt. of India, New Delhi. A number of seats in these courses are reserved for nationals of various countries. Foreign Students desirous of joining these professional courses should contact the nearest Indian Mission for necessary information.

The applicant will have to deposit the eligibility fee as under while submitting the application (Appendix-II) complete in all respects with the required documents/information for issuance of eligibility certificate:
