An eminent scholar with published work of high quality actively engaged in research with 10 years of experience in Post Graduate teaching, and/or experience in research at the University/National Level institutions, including experience of guiding research at doctoral level.

OR

An outstanding scholar with established reputation who has made significant contribution to knowledge.

READER

Good academic record with a Doctoral degree or equivalent published work. In addition to these, candidates who join from outside the University system, shall also possess at least 55 % of the marks or its equivalent grade of B in the 7 point scale with latter grades O, A, B, C, D, E, & F.
